Family Law Guidelines – Important Information for Families

The department recognises that family breakdowns take place. Unless there is formal notice otherwise, it is assumed that both parents have shared and equal parental responsibility for their children and both parents have been involved in decisions regarding their children's education. This also means the school recognises that each parent has equal duties, obligations, responsibilities and opportunities relating to matters involving the school.

It is not the role of schools to enforce family court orders or resolve family law disputes.

If changes occur in your family relationship which might impact on the relationship between the school and your family, you should advise the school immediately. This includes providing copies of any relevant court orders as soon as possible.

Lost Property

Our SRC students assist in the weekly return of all labelled items. While every effort is made to locate to the owners of lost property, the school cannot be responsible for any lost items.

Parents and families can support their children and the school by:

- keeping all items of personal value at home, for example toys, jewellery, personal devices etc.;
- ensuring all items of clothing, lunch boxes, school bags, pencil cases are clearly labelled with their child's name and class; and
- encouraging their children to regularly check the lost property box for individual items.

The lost property box is located near the front office. Unmarked items are donated to charity at the end of each term.

Digital Technologies

Digital technologies is a new curriculum area that was introduced with the new science syllabus in 2019. This year students will engage in digital technologies lessons taught by our skilled team of RFF teachers. The programs are aimed at ensuring our children are equipped with the necessary technological knowledge and skills to thrive in the future. Students will learn about digital systems and have opportunities to design creative solutions to problems.

Tickets are on sale through Flexischools for the upcoming Interrelate evening Questions Kids Have About Puberty. The March 10 event starts at 6:00pm and is broken up into two 60-minute sessions, with a 15-minute break in between. The first session is Where Did I Come From? and is aimed at Year 3 and 4 students and their parents/carers. The second session is Preparing For Puberty and is aimed at Year 5 and 6 students and their parents/carers. The price is \$32 per family for one session or \$37 per family to attend both. 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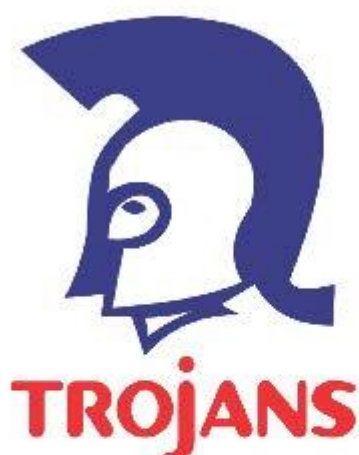
