Learning & Support Team

The Role of The Learning and Support Team



The school learning and support team plays a key role in coordinating and planning support for students with disability and additional learning needs.

Our Learning and Support Team is a group of professionals that meet each fortnight to discuss specific strategies to assist students requiring additional support in areas of learning and behaviour. The Learning and Support Team coordinates the development, implementation, monitoring and evaluation of learning support plans. The team consists of the Deputy Principal - Wellbeing and Engagement, who is also the LST Coordinator, School Counsellor, Learning and Support Teacher and when relevant classroom teachers.



Process of Referral to the Learning and Support Team

Students requiring additional support at school may be identified by teachers and/or parents. Through teacher and parent consultation these students may be referred to the school's Learning and Support Team. This team then discusses the most appropriate form of support and intervention for the student and communicates this outcome to parents/carers. In these cases, written permission will be sought from parents and carers and the LST will liaise with outside service providers, as required.

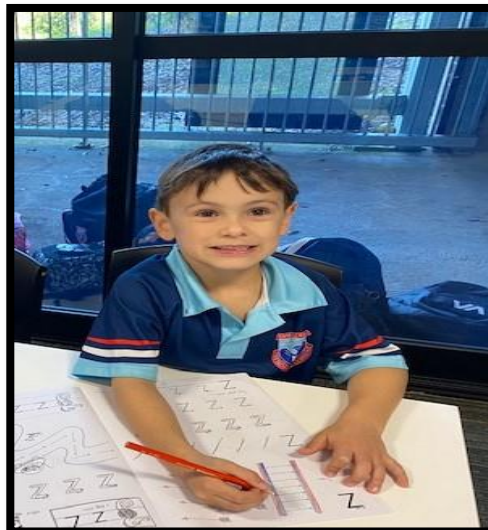

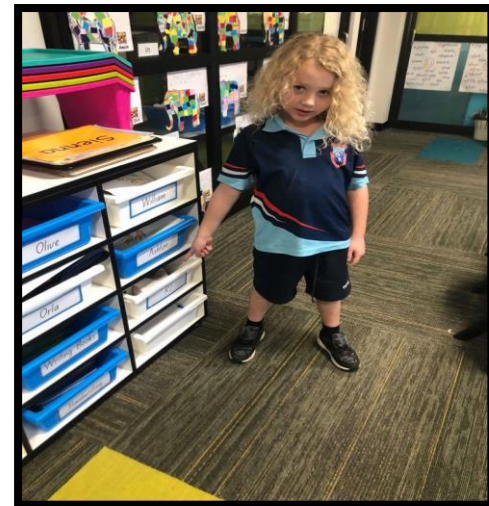
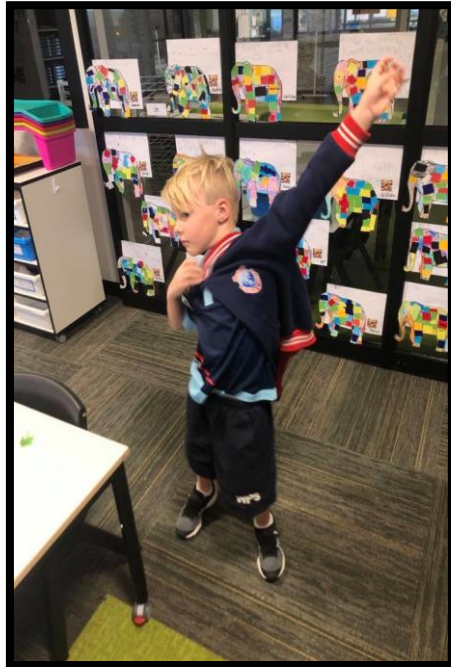
