Onsite Orientation Days

- Each child and one parent attends one session in 2021.
- Please don't arrive until the session start time.
- Please enter via the basketball court and follow the signs to the east side of the hall for sign in and vaccination sighting procedures.
- School staff will escort families along outdoor areas.
- Parents farewell children at the classrooms.
- Parents arrive at the end of the session time to collect their children from the basketball court.
- The 2022 session will follow the same process.

Kindergarten 2022 Teachers

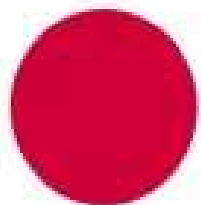
- Your child will work with the 2021 Kindergarten teachers during orientation in 2021.

- Meet the Teacher opportunities will be held early in the new year, in accordance with the current COVID safe requirements.

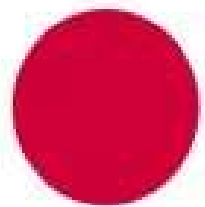




School Finishing Times

- Orientation and Best Start Sessions will be held from Tuesday 1 February 2022 to Friday 4 February 2022.
- First day of Kindergarten 2022 will be Monday 7 February 2022.
- For the Week Monday 7 February 2022 to Friday 11 February 2022, the Kindergarten day will conclude at 2:45 p.m.
- Kindergarten students who do not have a sibling at WPS will be able to be collected from the basketball court by their parent at 2:45 p.m. on these days.
- All other Kindergarten students will remain at school to be collected by parents with their siblings, get buses or attend The Y After School as appropriate.

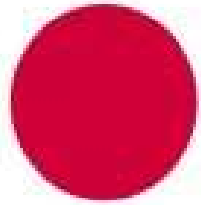

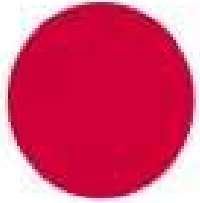

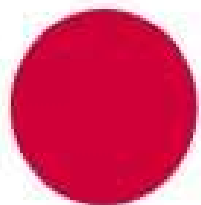

Departures

- Parents are encouraged to clarify the after school arrangements with their child each day.

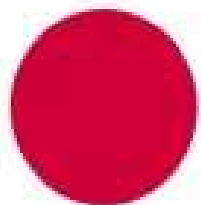




Buses

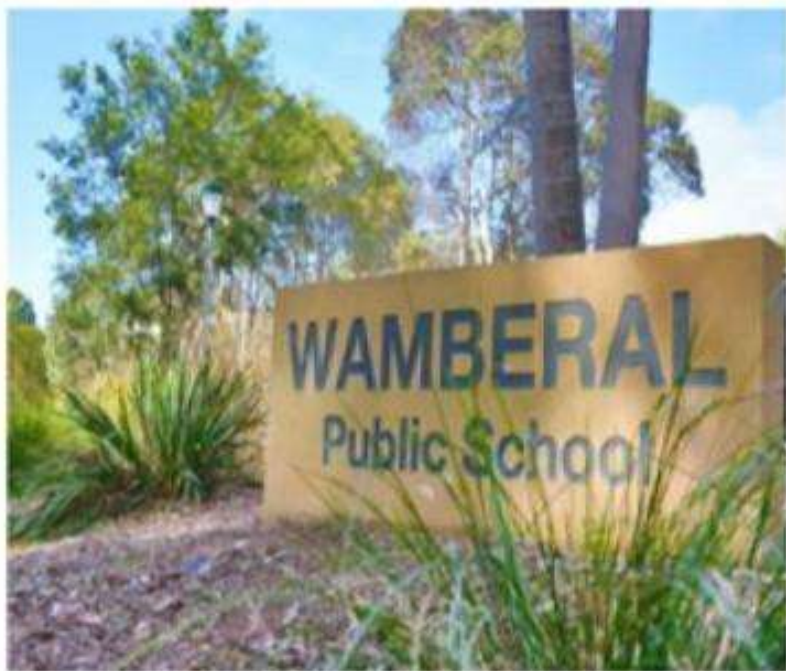
