Koori Choir	Your child has expressed interest in joining the Koori Choir. Koori Choir is a wonderful way to promote and celebrate awareness of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander traditions and we welcome all Indigenous and non-Indigenous students from Wamberal Public School. Please be aware this is a year-long commitment.
Brief Description	The Tuggerah Lakes Learning Community (TLLC) Koori Choir was initiated in 2007 to enhance the schools' endeavours to promote, learn about and actively engage in celebrating Indigenous culture and reconciliation for all students. Each year students from Wamberal Public School proudly participate and represent their school along with seven other participating schools within the TLLC when attending workshops and festivals.
Koori Choir Practice	Each week Koori Choir students from Wamberal PS will come together during lunch time in Mrs Burgess's room to learn and practice songs in preparation for our workshops which occur each Term at one of the seven TLLC schools.
Venue	TLLC Koori Choir students will perform at various venues throughout the year. Students will also perform at school events such as NAIDOC Week, Education Week and Grandparents Day, where parents, families and community members are welcome to attend.
Group / Year / Classes involved	Stage 2 and 3 students.
Transport	Bus will be provided to transport students to and from the performance.
Dress requirements	Long black pants, black shoes and socks, a black T-shirt. (When attending workshops and performing).
Cost	Nil.
Behavior	Student behaviour is considered when assessing the risk of excursions and extra-curricular events for the health and safety of all students and staff. Students must behave appropriately at all times on excursions. The school's discipline policy applies for the duration of this event.
