Our school is seeking an expression of interest from students to participate in the 3-6 Choir for 2023.

<b>3-6 Choir – what is it?</b>	Your child has expressed interest in joining the 3-6 Choir.  Students will learn techniques of choral singing and will sing a range of songs in unison and two-part harmony. With a range of styles, there is sure to be something for everyone. Our number one aim – have fun and enjoy music! No audition is required.
<b>Who can join?</b>	Stage 2 and 3 students.
<b>3-6 Choir rehearsals</b>	Weekly, Tuesday mornings before school from 9:00am – 9:30am in 3 Orange (Mrs Burgess's classroom). Parents/carers will need to ensure students arrive at school by 8.50am ready for a 9.00am start on choir days.  <b>First rehearsal Tuesday, 14<sup>th</sup> March.</b>
<b>3-6 choir performances</b>	Various school based and local performance opportunities throughout the year.
<b>Cost</b>	Performances outside of school may require payment for bus travel to and from venues.
<b>Cost</b>	Nil
<b>Behavior</b>	Student behaviour is considered when assessing the risk of excursions and extra-curricular events for the health and safety of all students and staff. Students must behave appropriately at all times on excursions. The school's discipline policy applies for the duration of this event.
<b>What's the commitment?</b>	No audition is required. Students may come to choir on a trial basis for the first two weeks, and after that will need make a commitment to rehearsals and performances for the whole year.
<b>Arrival procedures</b>	Students will meet Mrs Burgess outside the school office at 8:50am and will move to the rehearsal with the group.

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#### Health Care Needs

When a medical practitioner has prescribed medication (including emergency medication) that will need to be administered during the event, parents are responsible for:

- bringing this need to the attention of the school, including completing a written request to administer medication (forms are available on the school website);
- ensuring that the information is updated if it changes;
- supplying the medication and any 'consumables' necessary for its administration in a timely way;
- ensuring the medication is well within its expiry date; and
- collaborating with the school in working out arrangement for the supply and administration of the prescribed medication for the duration of the event.

For some events, the school will ask parents to supply the medication in a different way to what has already been agreed by the school. For example, parents may be asked to supply an additional adrenaline autoinjector (i.e. *EpiPen*® / *Anapen*®).

For asthma and anaphylaxis it is important for students to have immediate access to their medication. Please consider whether your child should carry their own *EpiPen*®, *Anapen*® or asthma reliever medication while at school. Permissions for students to carry their own asthma or anaphylaxis medication can be downloaded from the school website.
