Brief Description	The boys and girls Wamberal Public School soccer teams will participate in a PSSA gala day. Each team will play a minimum of two games. There will be 14 players per team.
Venue	Pat Morley Oval – Cresthaven Avenue, Bateau Bay
Day and Date	Thursday 1 June 2023 Permission note is due Wednesday 31 May 2023
Time of departure and return	The boys' first game will be at 11am . They are required to be at the venue no later than 10am . The girls' first game will be at 10am They are required to be at the venue no later than 9:15am . The event should finish about 2:30pm .
Group / Year / Classes involved	Selected Years 5-6 students will be attending - 28 Stage 3 Boys and Girls
Transport	Travel will be by private car. Parents are to make arrangements for their child to be transported to and from the venue. Please contact Mr Foyel or Mrs Herring if you are unable to do this.
Cost	Please bring \$4 on the day to cover referee fees and the cost of the ground. In case of financial difficulties, please contact the Deputy Principal, Mrs. Rees.

Staff member with CPR/emergency care training	Mr James Foyel and Mrs Kristy Herring
Dress requirements	Soccer jerseys will be provided. Students will need to wear shorts and socks similar to the colour of the school uniform (Black shorts/socks are okay). They will need to bring a school hat, shin pads and soccer/football boots. Boots must not be longer than 21mm and must not have any ridges, burring or sharp edges. Goal keepers will need to bring their goalie gloves. Please let Mr Foyel or Mrs Herring know if you require shin pads.
Sun safety requirements	Please ensure your child has appropriate sun protection including a hat and sunscreen.
Other requirements	Students will need to bring a water bottle, sunscreen, recess and lunch on the day. Please pack food and water for the whole day. There will be no canteen at the ground.
Behaviour	Student behaviour is considered when assessing the risk of excursions and extra-curricular events for the health and safety of all students and staff. Students must behave appropriately at all times on excursions. The school's discipline policy applies for the duration of this event.

Health Care Needs

When a medical practitioner has prescribed medication (including emergency medication) that will need to be administered during the event, parents are responsible for:

- bringing this need to the attention of the school, including completing a written request to administer medication (forms are available on the school website);
- ensuring that the information is updated if it changes;
- supplying the medication and any 'consumables' necessary for its administration in a timely way;
- ensuring the medication is well within its expiry date; and
- collaborating with the school in working out arrangement for the supply and administration of the prescribed medication for the duration of the event.

For some events, the school will ask parents to supply the medication in a different way to what has already been agreed by the school. For example, parents may be asked to supply an additional adrenaline autoinjector (i.e. *EpiPen*® / *Anapen*®).

For asthma and anaphylaxis it is important for students to have immediate access to their medication. Please consider whether your child should carry their own *EpiPen*®, *Anapen*® or asthma reliever medication while at school. Permissions for students to carry their own asthma or anaphylaxis medication can be downloaded from the school website.
