<b>Brief Description</b>	Students from Years 2 to 6 are invited to participate in the school cross country carnival.
<b>Venue</b>	Wamberal Public School
<b>Day and Date</b>	Tuesday 29 March, 2022 In the event of poor weather, the event may be postponed to Friday 29 April 2022. Details will be communicated via Skoolbag App. <b>Permission notes are due by Friday 25th March 2022.</b>
<b>Time</b>	Students will come to school as normal.
<b>Group / Year / Classes involved</b>	The races will be run in the following order: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• 8/9yrs</li><li>• 10yrs</li><li>• 11yrs</li><li>• 12/13yrs</li></ul> <p><i>The first race will begin at approximately 9:45am, with each race beginning every 20 - 30 mins (excluding lunch and recess breaks)</i></p> <p>Please be aware that whilst all students in Year 2-6 are eligible to compete in the WPS Cross Country, it is a requirement of Tuggerah Lakes Zone that competitors must be turning 8 in 2022. <b>Parents who wish to spectate during the cross country will need to sign in/sign out via the office and also complete the QR code on arrival.</b></p>
<b>Cost</b>	There will be no cost for this event
<b>Accompanying staff</b>	Teachers from Year 2 to 6
<b>Staff member with CPR/emergency care training</b>	All teachers attending
<b>Dress requirements</b>	School all-purpose uniform or sports uniform, including school hat. All clothing should be clearly labelled with your child's name.
<b>Other requirements</b>	It is essential that every child brings a <b>drink bottle filled with water</b> , suitable running shoes and ample sunscreen.
<b>Behaviour</b>	Student behaviour is considered when assessing the risk of excursions and extra-curricular events for the health and safety of all students and staff. Students must behave appropriately at all times on excursions. The school's discipline policy applies for the duration of this event.

\_\_\_\_\_ *When a medical practitioner has prescribed medication (including emergency medication) that will need to be administered during the excursion, parents are responsible for:*

- *Bringing this need to the attention of the school, including completing a written request to administer medication (forms are available from the front office or via the school website).*
- *Ensuring that the information is updated if it changes.*
- *Supplying the medication and any 'consumables' necessary for its administration in a timely way. The medication should be well within its expiry date.*
- *Collaborating with the school in working out arrangements for the supply and administration of the prescribed medication for the duration of the excursion. For some excursions the school will ask you to supply the medication in a different way to what has been already been agreed to by school. You may be asked to supply an additional adrenaline autoinjector (i.e. EpiPen® /Anapen ®) for example.*

For asthma and anaphylaxis it is important for students to have immediate access to their medication. Please consider whether your child should carry their own EpiPen®, Anapen® or asthma reliever medication to school and while they are at school. If you would like the school to consider your request for your child to carry their medication, please complete the form 'Request for student to carry his/her own medication' form available for download from our school website.
